# FREE SUMMER EVENTS KICK OFF AT THE SQUARE

**Portland, Ore.** — (June 1, 2023) — Pioneer Courthouse Square (The Square), the place where Portland comes together, kicks off the summer season downtown with an array of programming for residents, tourists, and workers. Starting June 6, Portland will have access to free weekly events aimed at wellness, culture, and community building. Opened in 1984 through a citizen-led effort, The Square has a history of holding more than 300 events per year. From music to art to cultural celebrations, the summer events continue The Square's mission of remaining a foundation of a diverse and thriving downtown.

Noon Tunes Summer Concert Series presented by 101.9 Kink: Downtown Portland's longest running concert series, Noon Tunes, returns for its 31st year at The Square. In partnership with KINK K101.9, talented local musicians will perform live on Tuesdays over the noon hour. With seven free concerts, dancing, and some of Portland's favorite food vendors at Carts on The Square, Portland's Living Room is sure to be downtown's summer lunchtime destination.

Portland Opera a la Cart: The Square is pleased to partner once again with the Portland Opera to bring Opera a la Cart live performances back this summer on select Thursdays over the lunch hour on. Inspired by Portland's food cart culture, Opera a la Cart is a mobile performance venue that serves up local artists singing live opera to the community. (July 6, and 20 / August 3, 17, and 31)

Flicks on the Bricks Presented by SmartPark: Portland's free outdoor movie series returns to Portland's Living Room this summer. During the three-day event, The Square will be transformed into Portland's largest outdoor movie theater for all community members to appreciate. All movies will be shown on a large LED screen, which will expand daytime movie offerings for children and adults and increase clarity in evening hours.

This year, The Square has added a limited section of theater-style seating for viewers to use. In keeping with The Flicks on the Bricks tradition, The Square continues to welcome movie viewers to bring their own low-back chairs, blankets, pillows, cushions, or bean bags to truly make The Square their "Living Room" during each movie. Admission is free and all seating occupancy will be available on a first come, first serve basis.
